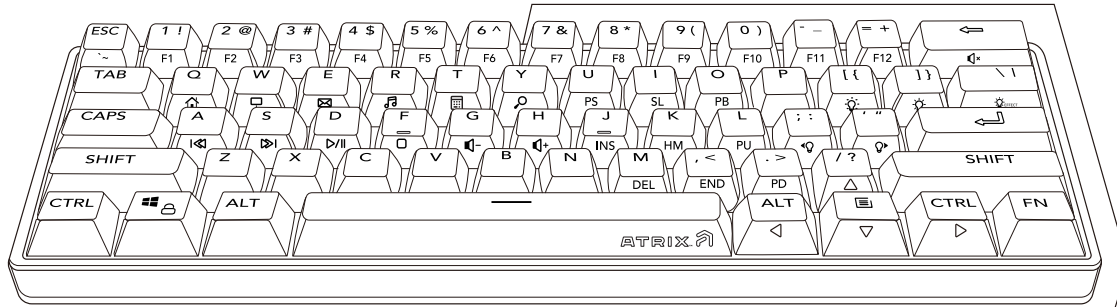

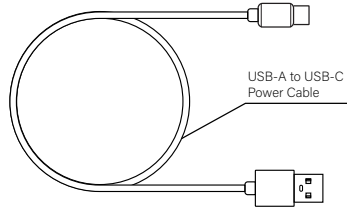

Custom Light Settings

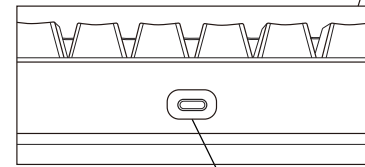
- To set custom light settings press FN+P once, and then press FN+P again to start recording.
