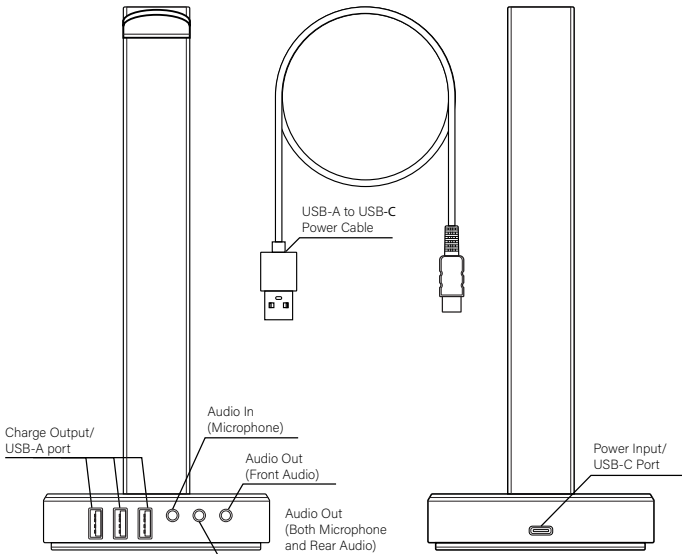

What's Included

- Headphone Stand
- USB-A to USB-C Cable

Headphone Stand Set Up

- Place the headphone stand on a sturdy flat surface.
- Connect the included USB cable into the base of the headphone stand and the USB-A end of the cable into a USB port on your PC or laptop.
- Plug any headset or headphones with a 3.5 mm Audio Jack into the green (front) audio out AUX port.
- To use a microphone plug a headset with a 3.5mm audio jack into the pink audio in AUX port.
- When the headphone plug is single and four pins, plug it into the rear audio port. When the headphone plug is double with three pins, plug the audio pin into the green port and the microphone pin into the pink port.
- To get high quality surround sound plug a headset that is surround sound compatible into the black (rear) audio out AUX port and Front Audio port.



7.1 Audio Setup

- For 7.1 enhanced audio driver use the qr code or navigate to <http://www.gemsfindyours.com/atrix-wired-headset> and download the zip file. Then follow the easy steps:
1. Extract the zip file contents to a folder on your computer.
2. Plug your headset into your headset stand.
3. Plug your headset stand into your PC.
4. Run the 'Setup.exe' and follow the prompts.



USB-A Out Ports

- This stand has three 2.0 USB-A ports capable of sending and receiving data and charging devices like headsets, phones, and tablets at high speeds.
